




North American Division Beginning and Ending Membership Comparison through 2nd Quarter 2023








Baptisms 1st and 2nd Quarter 2013-2023


















NAD Baptisms/Profession of Faith/Transfers In Totals 2013 through 2nd Quarter 2023















North American Division Deaths 2013-2nd Quarter 2023

Additions by baptism and profession of faith for every 100 members at the beginning of the year.






Rate of Net Growth




2022 Gender—North American Division




North American Division Members by Age













2023 NAD Congregational Attendance







Declining Median Worship Attendance Among U.S. Congregations












Growth five percent or more in past five years








NAD Congregations: Grew Five Plus Percent in Last Five Years








Not All Congregations Are in Decline: A Third Grew in the Last Five Years








NAD Congregation Growth in the last 5 years








Age Groups vs. Population







The Average Age of Clergy Is Generally on the Rise








NAD Average Age of Clergy


