




2008 - 2012




2011 Total Tithe - \$923,139,207

2012 Total Tithe - \$932,651,081 - Avg. \$17,935,597 per/wk




#### **North American Division Tithe**







#### For Past 10 Years




### Increase (Decrease) in Missions 2006 - 2012






## 2012 Gross Tithe used for the 2014 Tithe Budget








#### Growth of \$100 Invested In Various Indexes For the Period December 31, 1986 to September 30, 2013



## August 2013 Investments Managed by the General Conference







S&P 500 Feb 1 to Oct 1, 2013



#### RECOMMEND:
