

30,000 Friends giving their hearts to Jesus through baptism













Evangelistic Caravans

WHAT IT IS

One message, one night preaching Developed in three stages

- 1. SOWING by Training Caravan 2 hour presentation
- 2. CULTIVATION by building relationships to introduce Christ 4 months local church responsibility (weakest point)
- 3. HARVEST by Reaping Caravan 2 hour celebration

TRAINING CARAVAN

- GOAL: Motivate, train, and equip entire church with their pastor on reaching their friends using Christ's method
- HOW: To those who accept to pray and work for 5 persons within their circle of influence, we provide resources to reach them for Jesus and His church.





REAPING CARAVAN

- GOAL: Celebrate the work done by members under pastor's leadership
- HOW: Baptismal ceremony, a call to those members' friends who did not respond yet



RESULTS



- 1. Tithe increased 9% from previous month
- 2. Pastors who previously baptized 15-30 a year doubled the success
- 3. Apostasy decreased since new believer was
 - (1) brought by members (family)
 - (2) incorporated to small group experience (containment)
 - (3) provided with resources (discipleship)
- 4. Church member is more supportive of pastor and the organization
- 5. Last 10 years: membership went from 24M to 43M, that is a sustainable growth close to 8% annually

LOW COST



Centered in

1. Equipping the members with resources so they can bring their friends to Christ

- 2. Providing a Bible instructor one month prior to reaping caravan to assist members with their friends decisions
- 3. Speaker costs are spread around the Conference/Union



CULTURE OF EVANGELISM

- It took us time to see greater results
 - At the beginning, combined churches (9) involved with caravans baptized between 300-400
 - More recently up to 1,200 (16)



CULTURE OF EVANGELISM



- In order to expand effectiveness we produced movies to assist church members to reach their friends
- If the world uses them to introduce a different mind set, often contrary to Judeo-Christian values, why not use them to expand God's kingdom



HISPANICS EASIER TO BE REACHED?



- New comers into a town/city (no matter the culture, background, or nationality) are looking for connections
- Hispanic churches are learning the importance of providing a place like "family" that provides love and friendship
- Result: New comers tend to come and stay













