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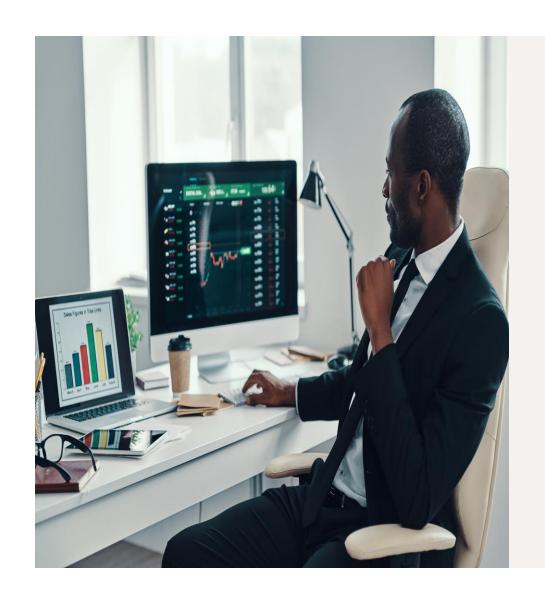

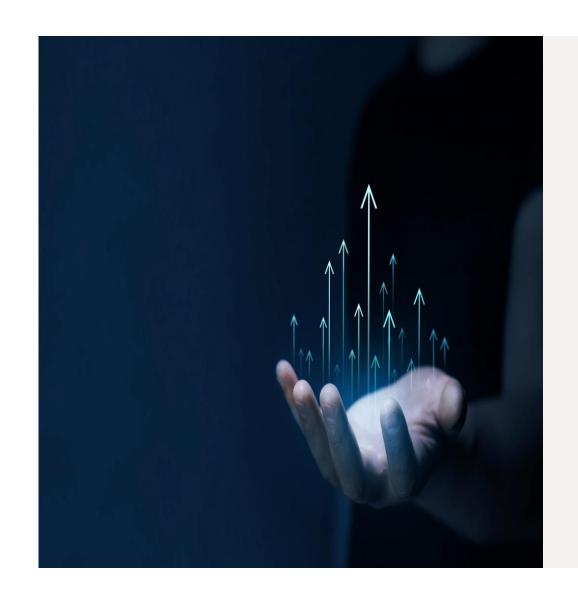




### Vital Records

Data of great value to administrators, church growth specialists, scholars & others





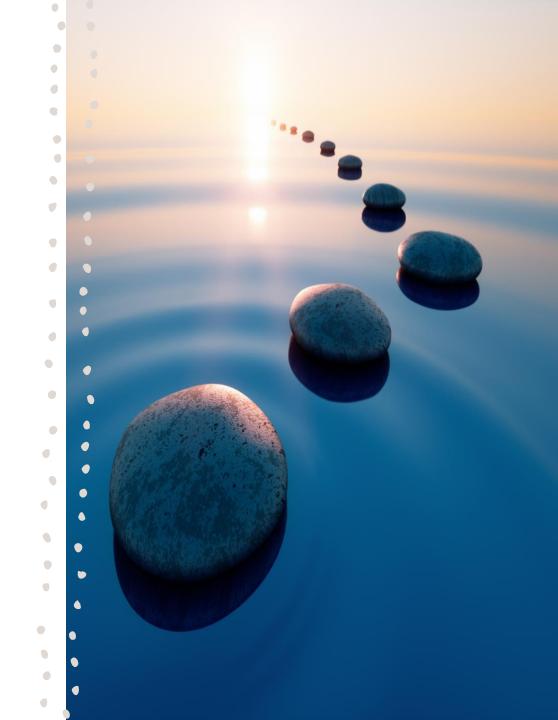
### Trends in Growth

### Denominationally Employed Workers (DEW) Annual Report

What is DEW Annual Report?

Count of denominational employees for full year (January 1 through December 31) by credential or license from each Conference & Union and entities/Educational /Healthcare entities



### Denominationally Employed Workers (DEW) Annual Report

Why DEW Annual Report necessary?

Provides division-wide report of credentialed ministers, licensed ministers, pastoral employees (includes commissioned ministers), teachers, healthcare employees, and part-time & temporary employees

Assists GC ASTR in tracking overall health and direction of world Church, via 13 divisions and 3 attached fields

PURPOSE OF Denominationally Employed Workers (DEW) Reports

Records brief but comprehensive picture of church's employment population by field

Data shows all full-time, part-time, temporary' employees, & LEs (literature evangelists)

^Non-licensed or credentialed employees

### Important Denominationally Employed Workers (DEW) Annual Report Deadlines



### DEW Annual Report Deadlines

**DUE DATE to NAD** Secretariat: March 15th

Unless GC Session Year, then

**DUE DATE:** February 15th

After which, NAD Secretariat compiles a full division report that includes all Unions/Conferences/Entities/Healthcare data & sends to GC ASTR

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What can Local Conference & Union Secretariat do to ensure DEW Report is completed & submitted by due date?

\*Unions are responsible for obtaining a report from each of their Conferences and any entities under the Union, which may or may not include healthcare entities and a full report needs to be compiled by the Union for the Division

\*Make time to complete DEW Report a **priority** 

\*Ensure designated person trained & experienced in completing DEW Report

\*If possible, assign more than one designated person in completing DEW Report

\*Provide time for training in Microsoft Excel & working with DEW Report
